

## Builders and Trade Contractors: Are you at risk of falling on the jobsite?

The content for the 4 –hour seminar is based on the English/Spanish NAHB-OSHA *Fall Protection Handbook* and *Fall Protection Video*, which are straightforward guides for builders, remodelers, and trade contractors that have been designed to show you how to eliminate the most common fall hazards found on home building jobsites and what you need to do to comply with OSHA fall protection regulations.

- Use safe work practices to reduce the risk of injuries
- Comply with OSHA fall protection regulations that apply to the home building industry
